Apple® IIGS® Version

This document contains the specific instructions for the Apple IIGS version of the program which do not appear in the manual. Please read this document before starting the game.

- **System Requirements:**

Apple IIGS with 1.25 Megabyte of memory
One 3.5" disk drive
GSOS System 5.0.4 or System 6.0

- **Hard Disk Drive Installation:**

Boot up your hard drive. In the Finder, make a new folder using any name you wish. Copy the files "Shanghai.II" and "DEPrefs" from Disk 1 and "DESounds" from Disk 2 to this new folder. To run the game, double-click on the file "Shanghai.II".

Note: This program uses resource files. Do not use a copy program that is not Finder friendly. If you are unsure of your copy program, use the Finder.

- **Running the game on a 3 1/2" drive only system:**

Use your System Disk to boot up either System 5.0.4 or System 6.0. At the Finder, insert Disk One (DE1) and double-click on the file "Shanghai.II". Please note that on a single drive system, multiple disk swaps will be necessary during game play if sounds

are enabled. If you wish to cut down on required disk swaps, please turn sounds off. You can disable the sound effects by choosing "Cancel" when the program asks for disk "DE2".

Note: *It is important that you make a backup copy of the game for your own personal use. If you are unfamiliar with copying disks, please refer to your Operator's Manual. Use the Backup disks to run the program because the program updates the files on these disks.*

- **Corrections to the Manual:**

1. To select a tileset, choose tileset under "Tile Menu". Selecting a new tileset does not start a new game.
2. To select a layout, choose the layout under the "Layout Menu."
3. There is no Layout construction function.
4. The program disk must not be write protected. The program updates the program files during operation.
